

## **Clarksville Surgery Center gets OK to build replacement facility**

Clarksville Surgery Center received approval last week from the Tennessee Health Services and Development Agency to build a replacement facility.

The 12,679-square-foot surgery center will be built on undeveloped property near Interstate 24 and Highway 76 along Hornbuckle Lane. The replacement facility will have three operating rooms and two non-sterile procedure rooms.

Keith Bolton, president of Nashville-based Specialty Surgery Centers of America, is the managing partner of Clarksville Surgery Center.

His company plans to develop 10 acres on the site as a medical campus that will include physician offices, physical therapy, a pain management clinic and other ancillary businesses. Construction is expected to begin early next year with a completion date in early 2007.

Bolton says the Clarksville center is projected to handle 3,600 medical procedures on 2,600 patients this year. The center, which opened in 1999, is located at the corner of Memorial Drive and Haynes Drive. The replacement facility will be designed by Steve Powell of Community Tectonics in Nashville.
